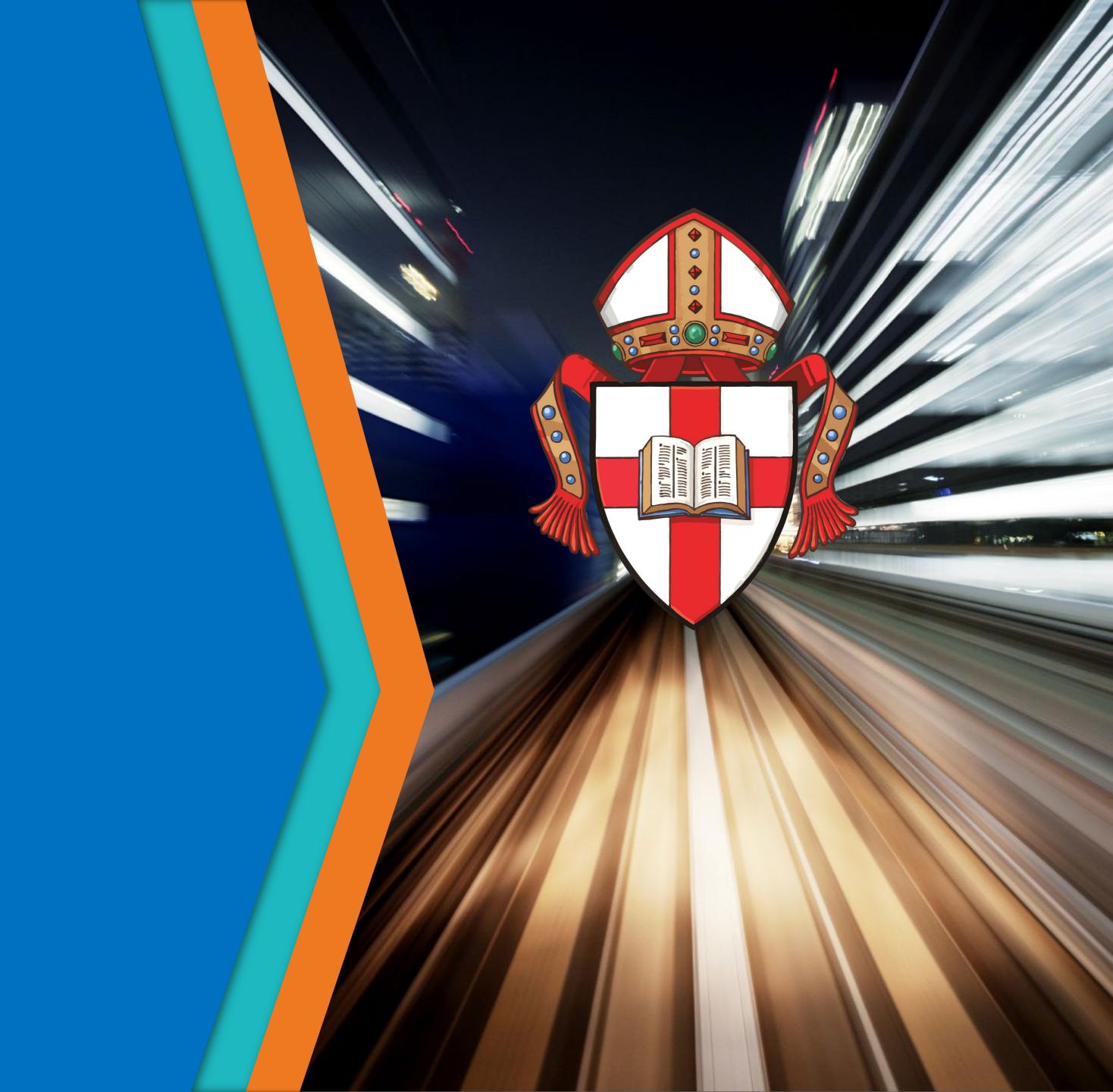

Continue to pursue cost and income opportunities

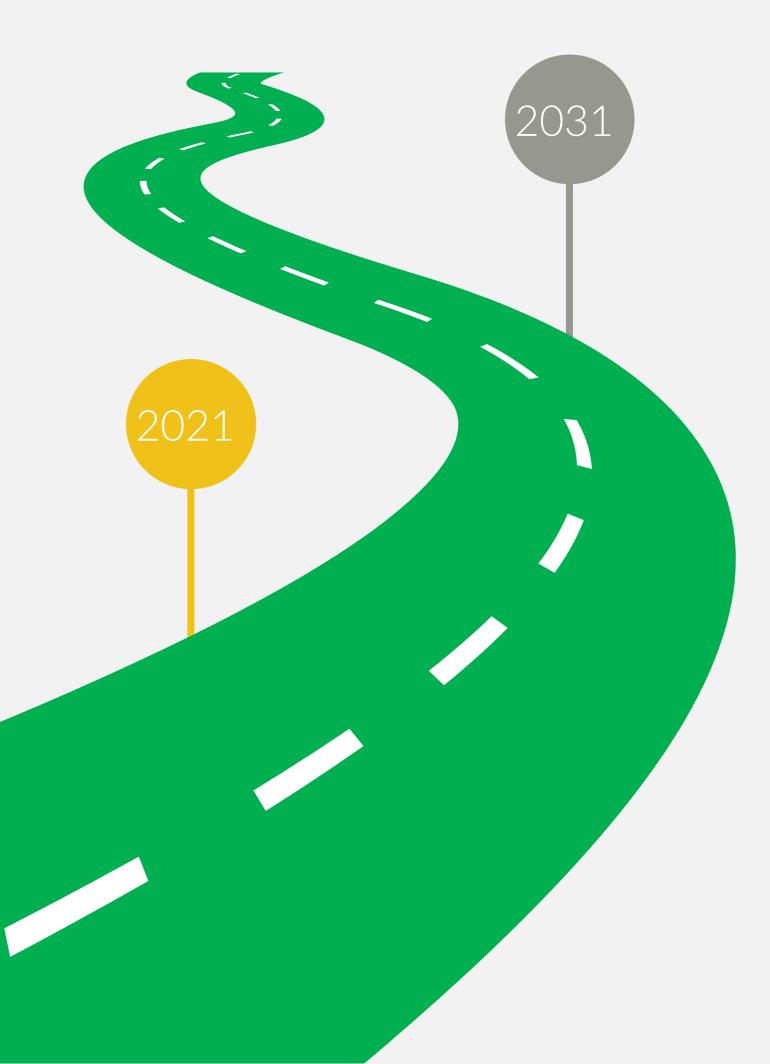

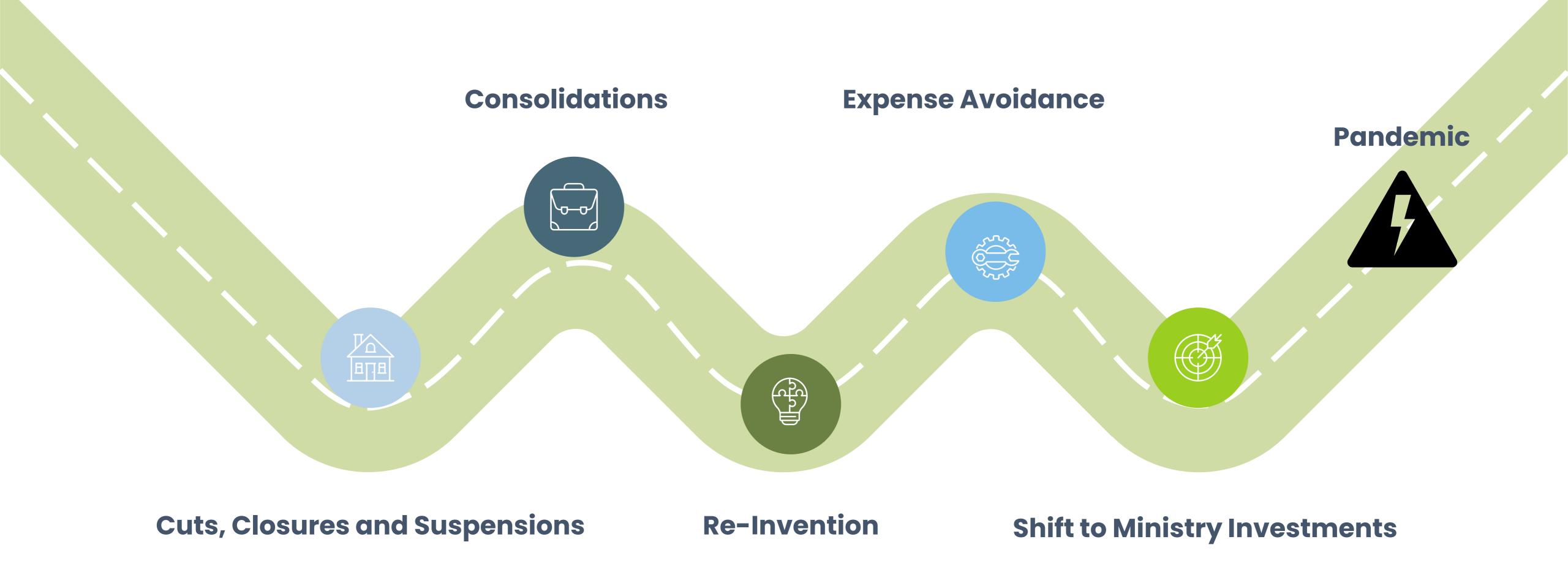

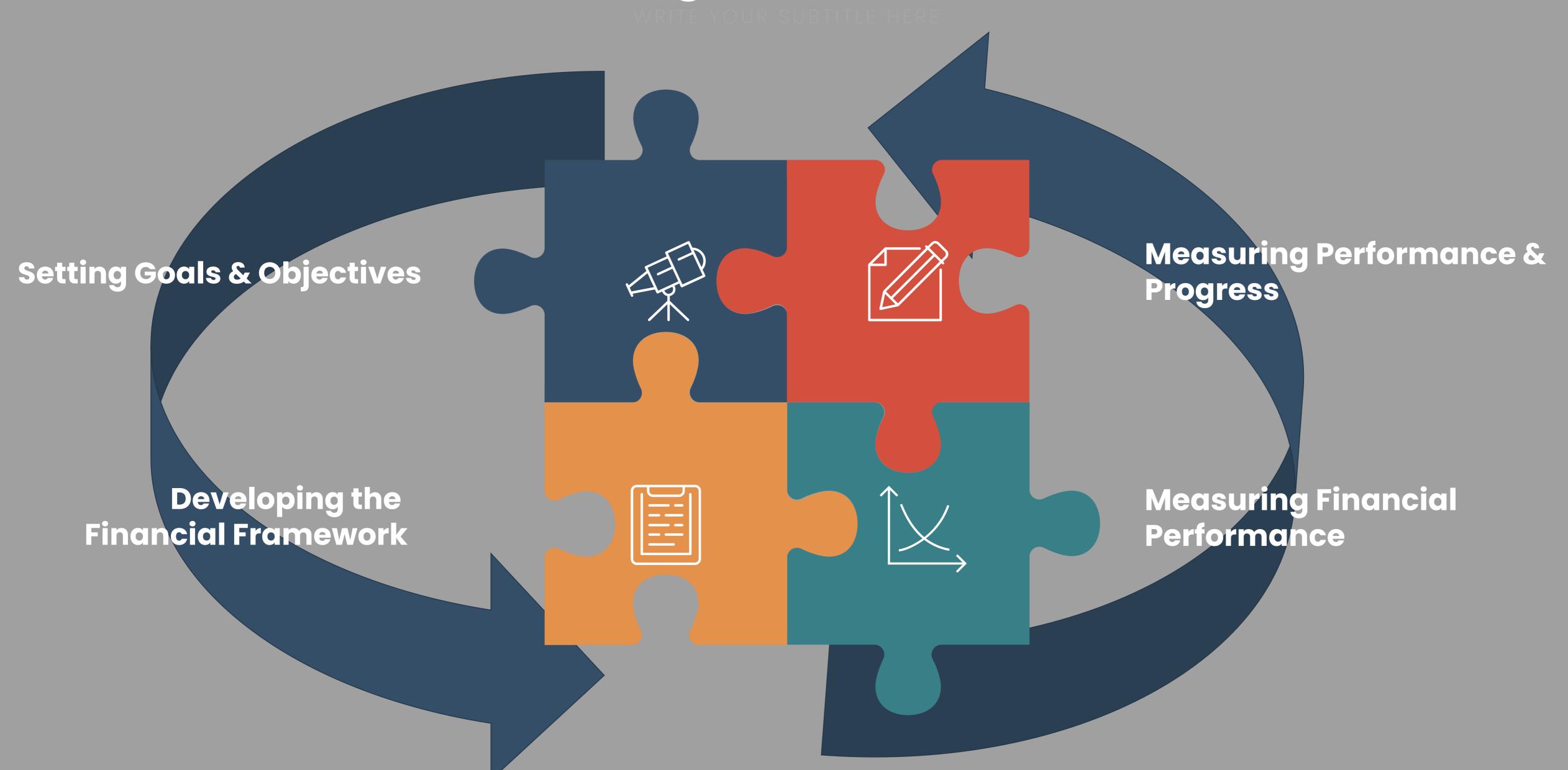

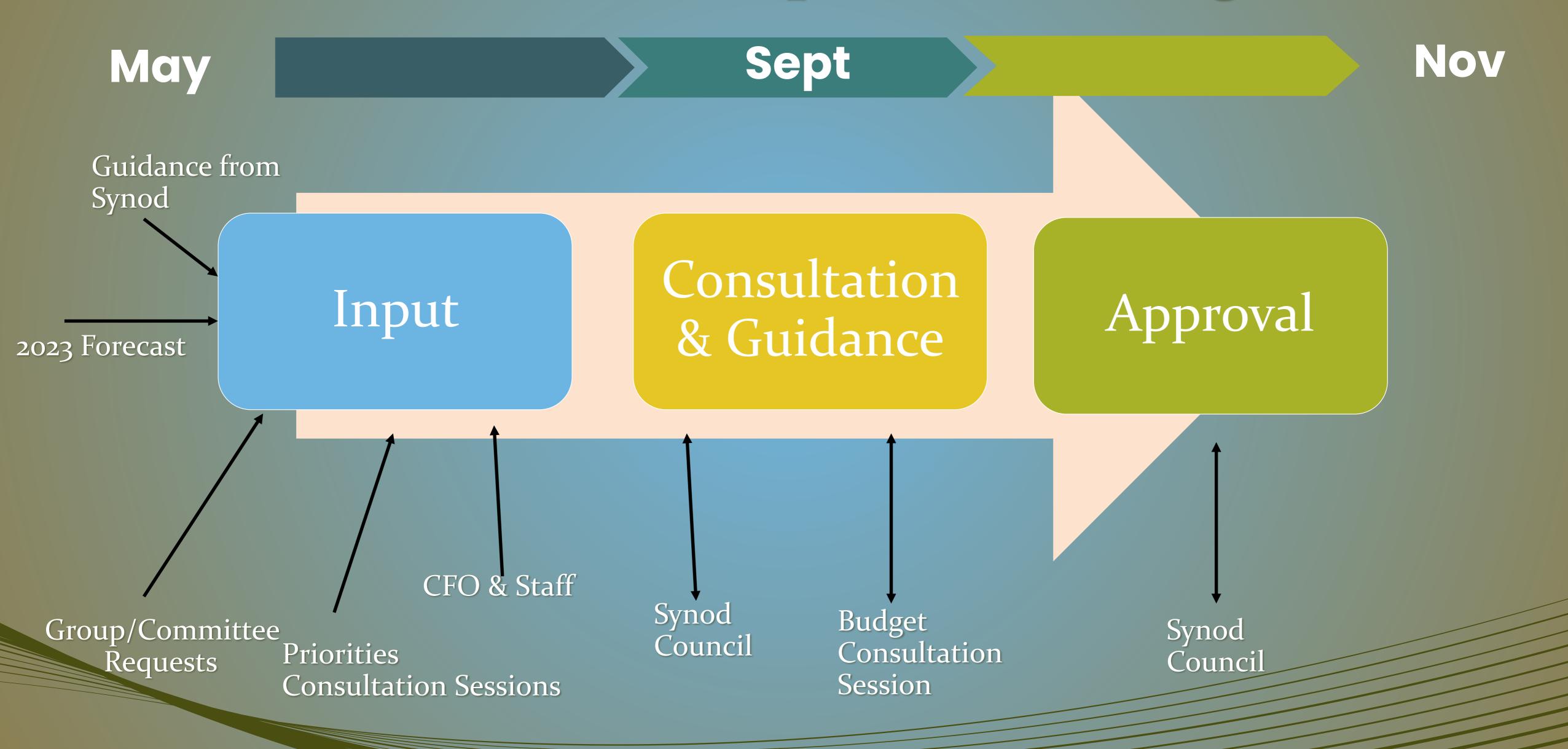

Financial Timeline & Focus

Based on Feedback and further discussion:

- 1) Defer developing the 3 year Financial Framework until the Episcopal change is completed and direction established
- 2) Based on Consultation, Guidance for the 2024 Budget has been developed. Synod Council ratification now sends it to Synod 2023
- 3) 2024 Budget to be developed through the Consultation process and brought to Synod Council for approval
- 4) Bring the Framework to Synod 2025

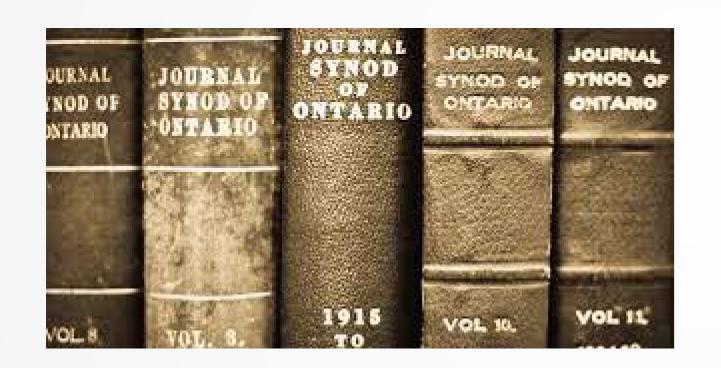

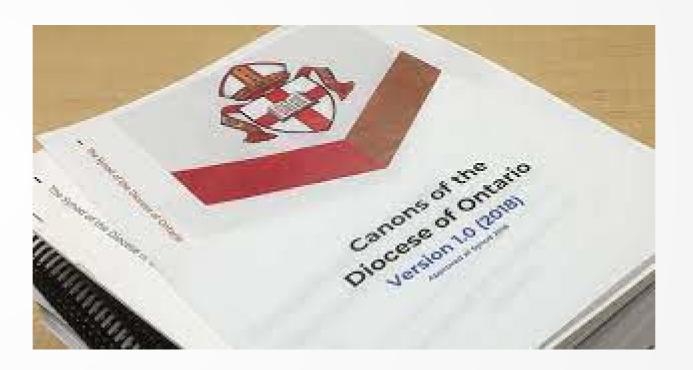

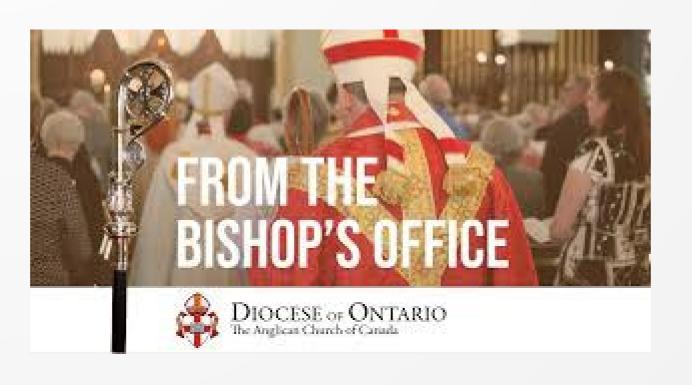
