DOORS, **information only:** DOORS is requesting a large (\$40-50,000) 2026 grant. This is the 30th anniversary of Diocese of Ontario involvement in refugee support.

The Diocese endorses a project, only one approved by the Foundation.

8. Historic Designation - Stirling

Canon Bob Wright asking for Historical designation for St. John's Stirling. This should make it more possible to get grants. St. John's Stirling was designed by the same architect of the House of Commons during the same time frame.

Why? Historically significant building; frees up granting opportunities.

BAO requests that each cemetery trust fund be individual trust funds. Other dioceses as well as ours are attempting to continue with a diocesan cemetery trust fund.

Investment fund portfolio statement planned for April Synod Council.

Detail work on 3-year financial plan continues.

For Synod 2025: Review historical (2020-2024) trends to plan for future.

Churches are asset rich but cash poor. Looking at strengthening church finances. Plan to use Summer Finance Student, if funding approved.

Question: CMM is estimated can it be moved to an actual?

One option: Submit "green sheet" (financials) by midyear or Diocese will get information from CRA and then submit a bill to the parish for 20% of the parish's income to Diocese as CMM.

Training session re: green sheets requested. Question: is there a simplified form for CMM?

Recently, as an ACC representative Interfaith Committee of Chaplaincy – Millhaven review. OPCOTE session last Friday, shared the diocesan's donation to LTh program.
